If you are unable to meet your tax, national insurance, VAT or other payments owed to HMRC or you expect cash flow will cause you problems, you can call the Business Support Service Line on 0845 302 1435, Monday to Friday 8-8pm; Weekends 8-4pm.

Forms P45 are changing..

From April 2009 the old style P45'S will be invalid. The new form P45 will have to be used as the old P45'S will not be accepted.

The new forms are A4 size in 4 parts.

VAT Returns online...

If your turnover figure is more than £100k (before VAT) then you will be required to complete your VAT returns online from 1st April 2010. You will need to register at www.hmrc.gov.uk

Online filing can help your cash flow

You get up to seven extra calendar days to submit your VAT return when you do it online. By paying electronically, you can also get up to seven extra calendar days to pay your VAT. If you pay by direct debit you have three further banking days before payment is taken from your account.
