

# “Green” Home Improvement Grants

## Factsheet

This is a great opportunity to not only have necessary work completed, at a reduced price, in a step towards becoming more energy efficient – but also a fantastic way to support your local tradesmen, who we all appreciate!

Homeowners and landlords will have the opportunity to get grants for 2/3 of the cost for insulation and other energy efficient measures (capped at £5,000). Some of the lowest income households will get the full 100% of costs of energy efficiency refits, paid up to £10,000. Though details on what is classed as low income is not yet clear.

Types of improvements offered may include:

- Wall-to-wall insulation
- Energy efficient boilers
- Double or triple-glazed windows
- Low-energy lighting
- Insulated doors

We hope for a more extensive guidance on the above to be released.

### Home Owners / Landlords

The scheme is planned to launch in September, at which point online applications will be accepted for the recommended home improvements, as well as the details for accredited suppliers.

After a quote is provided by one of the suppliers and the work is approved by the scheme, households will then be sent vouchers to cover a portion of the cost, and the installation can begin.

More comprehensive information about how to apply will be confirmed in the next two months.

### Trades Suppliers

If you provide some of the services detailed above, then you will need to become an accredited supplier so that customers are able to come to you for the services they need.

There is no information, as yet, on how to actually become an accredited supplier for this particular scheme. We will be keeping our eye on updates for this on a daily basis and will be in touch with any developments.
